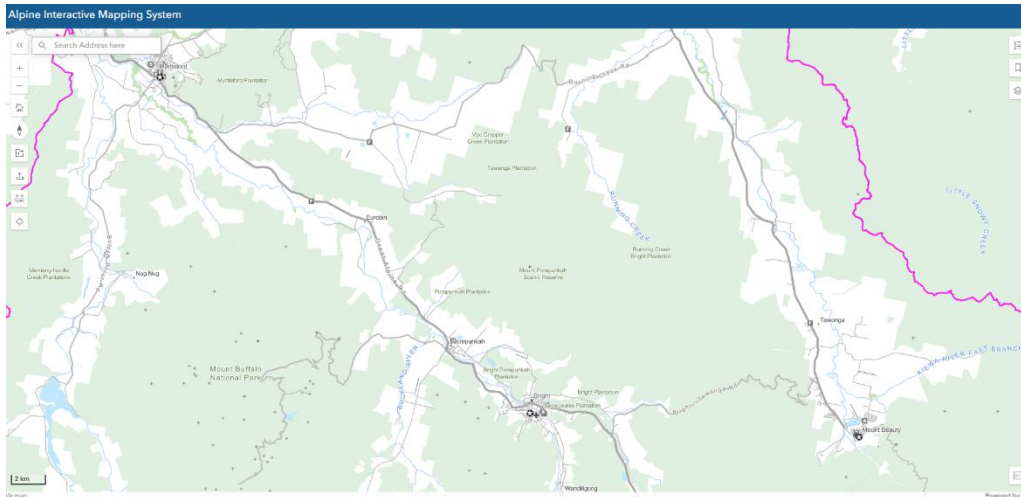



2. Next, you will see our Alpine Interactive Mapping System. On this page, you can zoom, pan, and select elements to access the data we have on display.

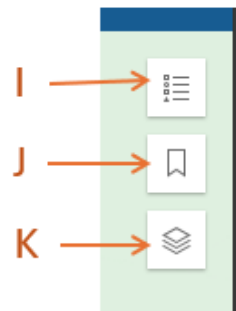


3. The buttons on the left side of the screen include:



- A. Search tool** (where you can search your address or use current location)
- B. Zoom** (in and out)
- C. Home view** (this is the current view when you first access the map)
- D. Navigation button**
- E. Share panel**
- F. Export button**
- G. Measure tool** (this tool also has coordinates information)
- H. Find my location** (useful if you are viewing this on a mobile device)

4. On the right side of the screen there are three more tools:
- I. Legend** (where you can see what the layers look like)
 - J. Bookmarks** (for quickly moving around the area)
 - K. Legend**



5. As you zoom in, you will see that the imagery turns on. If you want to turn this off, you can by selecting the legend button and unselecting **Aerial Imagery** and **World Imagery**.
6. If you select a property, it will highlight blue and a popup box will appear, which will inform you of the **waste collection days** for that property.
7. At the bottom of the popup box, you will see two arrows. Select these arrows to see **more information about the property**, such as parcel information, property numbers, and links to the Victorian Government's VicPlan website, where you will find planning information.
