



STREET CLOSURES - ANZAC DAY MOUNT BEAUTY

The following roads will be closed for short periods of time to allow the safe staging of the Mount Beauty ANZAC Day Service.

Mount Beauty

Monday 25 April 2022

10.30am to approximately 11.45am

- Lakeside Ave will be closed between Kiewa Valley Highway and Kiewa Cres. A detour will be in place for all vehicles, please follow the signs.
- Park St will be closed for a short period between Kiewa and Tawonga Cres for the march

*Note that this will also close Hollonds Street to through traffic. Any cars parked in Hollonds Street will be able to exit via Park Street after the march.

Draft Budget 2022/23

Council has prepared a draft Budget for the 2022/23 financial year and now invites community comment. Any person may make a written submission on the draft Budget.

Proposed Dinner Plain Special Rate 2022/23

Council is proposing to declare a Special Rate (the Dinner Plain Special Rate) for the 2022/23 financial year. The purpose of the Special Rate is to defray any expenses in relation to the provision of services of special benefit to the owners of Commercial / Industrial land within the Dinner Plain village. The basis of calculation of the Dinner Plain Special Rate will be 43% of the general rate. Any person may make a written submission on the proposed Special Rate.

Draft Asset Plan 2022-2031

Council has prepared a draft Asset Plan for the years 2022-2031. The draft Asset Plan outlines how Council's infrastructure assets will be managed and maintained, including roads and car parks, buildings, pathways, open space, drainage, and bridges. Any person may make a written submission on the draft Asset Plan.

How to make a Submission

Written submissions must be received by **5pm Thursday, 12 May 2022** by mail to: Submissions, Alpine Shire Council, PO Box 139, Bright 3741; email to submissions@alpineshire.vic.gov.au; or online at www.alpineshire.vic.gov.au/onexhibition.

Any person making a submission on the draft Budget or proposed Dinner Plain Special Rate may request that they or their representative appear in person in support of their submission, before a committee of Council. The request to be heard must be clearly specified in the written submission. Hearing of submissions will occur on the afternoon of **Tuesday 17 May 2022**. Council will contact those wishing to be heard to confirm the date and the time along with arrangements for presenting to Council.

Submissions on the draft Asset Plan do not include the opportunity to be heard in person.

Adoption of final documents

After considering submissions, Council will formally adopt the Budget, declare the Dinner Plain Special Rate, and adopt the Asset Plan at the Ordinary Council Meeting on 7 June 2022.

STREET CLOSURES - ANZAC DAY MYRTLEFORD

The following roads will be closed for short periods of time to allow the safe staging of the Myrtleford ANZAC Day Service.

MYRTLEFORD

Monday 25 April 2022

10.30am to approximately 12noon

- Great Alpine Road closed between Standish St and Albert St / Lewis Ave
- Clyde St will be closed between Standish St, Queen St and Great Alpine Road
- Smith St will be closed for a short period between the Myrtleford RSL Hall and Standish St for the march
- A detour will be in place for all vehicles, please follow the signs. Note: the detour is not suitable for vehicle exceeding 50 ton, these vehicles will be required to halt for approximately 1 hour during the service.
- The V/Line bus stops on Great Alpine Road will be temporarily moved to the corner of Albert and Elgin Sts, in front of the Old School Museum, for the duration of the closure.

STREET CLOSURES - ANZAC DAY BRIGHT

The following roads will be closed for short periods of time to allow the safe staging of the Bright ANZAC Day Service.

BRIGHT

Monday 25 April 2022

5.45am to approximately 6.45am

- Ireland Street closed at Barnard Street/ Camp Street intersection
- Ireland Street closed at the Cobden Street roundabout
- Burke Street closed at the roundabout (clock tower)
- Anderson Street closed at Wood Street intersection.

10.00am to approximately 12.00pm

- Ireland Street closed at Mafeking Square roundabout
- Ireland Street closed at the Cobden Street roundabout
- Bourke Street closed at the entry to the roundabout
- Anderson Street closed at Wood Street intersection
- Ireland Street closed at Poet's Corner

10.30am to approximately 11.00am

- Bakers Gully Rd closed between Park Street and Cobden Street to allow for the commencement of the march

Note: The V/Line bus stop in Anderson St will be moved to Apex Park on Gavan St (opposite Woolworths) for the duration of the closure.
