

PROPOSED ROAD DISCONTINUANCE

PUBLIC NOTICE INVITING SUBMISSIONS UNDER SECTION 223

Alpine Shire Council (**Council**), acting under section 206 and Clause 3 of Schedule 10 of the Local Government Act 1989 (**Act**), propose to discontinue the unnamed road (comprising a total area of 7,451sqm), which is hatched on the plan below.



In accordance with section 223 of the Act, any person wishing to make a submission on the proposal must do so in writing no later than October 20 2021. Submissions should be addressed to:

Submissions may also be delivered to Council's Service Centre, 2 Churchill Avenue, Bright or emailed to submissions@alpineshire.vic.gov.au.

A person making a submission is entitled to request in the submission that they wish to appear in person, or to be represented by a person specified in the submission, in support of the submission at a Council meeting or its committee on a date, time and place to be determined by Council.

Submissions made under section 223 of the Act are not confidential and:

- will be incorporated in full (including any personal information) into the agenda and minutes of any Council or committee meeting at which the matter is considered;
- will be available on Council's website as part of any relevant Council or committee agenda and minutes; and
- must be made available for public inspection in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

All submissions will be considered in accordance with section 223 of the Act.

Following consideration of submissions (if any) Council may resolve to discontinue the road, part of the road, or not to discontinue the road.
