KERBSIDE PRUNING COLLECTION

Council offers an annual collection of garden prunings from residents' naturestrips.

Collection will take place at:

Myrtleford: Monday 13 July - Friday, 17 July

Mount Beauty and Tawonga: Monday 20 July - Friday, 24 July

Porepunkah and Wandiligong: Monday 27 July - Friday 31 July

Bright: Monday 3 August - Friday 7 August

- Prunings will only be collected once per household on or near the date specified for each township. Households placing unacceptable material or not abiding by the timetable will be responsible for removing these items from the road reserve.
- Prunings placed on a nature strip too early will constitute a local law infringement i.e. no more than one week prior to the collection week.
- This collection program is for **PRIVATE TREE PRUNINGS ONLY**. Pruning of Council owned trees will constitute a local law infringement.
- Prunings must be:
 - Neatly stacked with ends facing the kerbside on the nature strip, not obstructing vehicular or pedestrian traffic;
 - Have a minimum diameter of 20mm for each pruning;
 - Have a maximum diameter of 200mm for each pruning;
 - Be **NO** longer than 2 metres in length;
 - Be **LESS** than 2 cubic metres total loose volume;
 - On the nature strip by the specified date; and
 - Not bound by wire.

The following materials **WILL NOT** be collected or chipped:

Vines and creepers

Blackberries, roses, bamboo, flax and palms

Tree stumps, and tree roots

Spiky citrus varieties

Wire, string, metal, plastics etc.
