Notice of the preparation of an amendment**

Amendment C60alp

The Alpine Shire Council has prepared Amendment C60 to the Alpine Planning Scheme.

The land affected by the amendment is:

- Bright Golf Club - 308 Back Porepunkah Road, Porepunkah, CA 14A Section 4, Parish of Porepunkah.
- Mount Beauty Golf Club - 19 Tawonga Crescent, Mount Beauty, CA 2D Section 4, Parish of Weramatong.
- Himalayan Oak (*Quercus lanata*) tree at Bright Cemetery - Part of CA 6D, Section F2, Township of Bright.
- Bright Cemetery (west side of central path uphill), 12-20 Coronation Ave, Bright
- Land Generally within Schedule 5 of the Special Use Zone (SUZ5) applying to Mount Beauty Air Park:

The amendment proposes to rectify various planning scheme errors and anomalies errors by:

- Rezoning land at the Bright and Mount Beauty Golf Clubs from Public Park and Recreation Zone to a new Special User Zone - Schedule 6 to reflect their current use as golf courses that are no longer on public land.
- Rezoning land owned by North East Water at Mount Beauty and Tawonga South from Public Conservation and Resource Zone to Public Use Zone 1 to reflect the current use of the land for utility purposes.

- Amending the Schedule to Clause 43.01, Heritage Overlay to replace the reference to *Quercus leucotrichophora* with *Quercus lanata*; and amend Heritage Overlay Map 9 to show the tree in the correct location.

- Amending Schedule 5 to the Special Use Zone to correct a range of errors and omissions.

Any person who may be affected by the amendment may make a submission to the planning authority about the amendment. Submissions must be made in writing giving the submitter's name and contact address, clearly stating the grounds on which the amendment is supported or opposed and indicating what changes (if any) the submitter wishes to make.

Name and contact details of submitters are required for council to consider submissions and to notify such persons of the opportunity to attend council meetings and any public hearing held to consider submissions. The closing date for submissions is 8 January 2021. A submission must be sent to the Alpine Shire, Box 139, Bright 3741.

The planning authority must make a copy of every submission available at its office and/or on its website for any person to inspect free of charge for two months after the amendment comes into operation or lapses.
