KERBSIDE PRUNING COLLECTION

Council offers an annual collection of garden prunings from residents' naturestrips.

Collection will take place at:

Myrtleford:

Monday 15 July - Friday, 19 July

Mount Beauty, Tawonga, Tawonga South:

Monday 22 July - Friday 26 July

Bright, Porepunkah, Wandiligong,

Freeburgh:

Monday 29 July - Friday 2 August

- Prunings will only be collected once per household on or near the date specified for each township. Households placing unacceptable material or not abiding by the timetable will be responsible for removing these items from the road reserve.
- Prunings placed on a nature strip too early will constitute a local law infringement i.e. no more than one week prior to collection.
- Prunings must be:
 - o Neatly stacked with ends one way on the naturestrip, not obstructing vehicular or pedestrian traffic
 - o Have minimum diameter of 20mm
 - o Have a maximum diameter of 200mm
 - o Be no longer than 2 metres
 - o Be less than 3 cubic metres total loose volume
 - o On the nature strip by the specified date.
- The following materials are unacceptable and will not be collected:
 - o Vines and creepers
 - o Blackberries, roses, bamboo, flax and palms
 - o Tree stumps, and tree roots
 - o Spiky lemon varieties
 - o Wire, string, metal, plastics etc.
